It's no surprise we want pets with us all the time! They make us laugh, keep us active and give us companionship so we don't feel alone.


Taking our dogs and cats with us on vacation means we get more quality time together and don't have to worry about leaving them behind.

Shoot pictures near a window or outside, where you'll have the best light. Don't use a flash, which can scare pets and create red eyes.





Don't try to force a pose or position. You'll get the best pictures if your pet is relaxed.






Holding a treat or toy by the camera is a great way to keep your pet focused on you. Just be sure to hand the treat over when done.





Sounds can be helpful too.

Whistle, use a squeaky toy or shake a treat jar to get your dog or cat to focus on you and the camera. But save the sound for when you really need it.





Think about what's in the background and where you want the focus to be.
